## **YOUTH INTERVIEW OF PARENT** Please Complete and turn in by February 14<sup>th</sup>.

Candidates choose at least 4 from among these questions as they interview their parent(s)/grandparents:

\*How, When, Where do you encounter God?

\*Who has been a “conferrer of God’s grace” for you? Who in your life has touched your life with goodness and grace; who has been a messenger of God in your life?

\*What is the biggest effect Jesus has on your everyday life?

\*What is one way your relationship with Jesus has changed since you were a teen?

\*What is one reason why I should be confirmed in the Catholic Faith and follow Jesus?

\*What is your favorite Gospel story? What does this story tell you about Jesus? How does it help you to know Jesus better? What is the lesson of this story that you would want to learn?

\*Who is the Holy Spirit for you? How have you experienced the Holy Spirit in your life? What difference does the Holy Spirit make in your life?

\*What does it mean to you to be Catholic?

**Questions for a parent of a Confirmation Candidate:

\*How can I, through my actions and my prayer, help ready this candidate for Confirmation?

\*How comfortable am I listening to, talking with, and praying with this candidate about my faith?

\*How does my life model the importance of regular Mass attendance?

\*How will I prioritize my other commitments to encourage the candidate's commitment to this process?

**QUESTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATE FOR CONFIRMATION:**

How do my actions and my personal prayer indicate at this time that I want to actively practice my faith?

How open am I to listening to the wisdom offered to me by others about my faith?

How important to me is regular attendance at Mass?

What actions am I willing to take to show my commitment and dedication to the Confirmation process?
